STORY OF GLEN, COOKIE, AND BRUNO

"They rescued me just as much as I rescued them."

I still remember the first time I walked into a pet market - I was young, naive, and had no idea what it meant to buy a pet. I just saw kittens in cages, and my heart was full of a gentle, hopeful longing. However, a few years ago, that innocence was shattered in an instant. I saw a world from where my heart can never go back - a reality of unfathomable cruelty where tiny lives were treated as mere commodities.

I saw three Persian kittens, huddled together in a small cage, shivering. Their coats were matted, their eyes infected, and their little bodies were

weak from neglect. The conditions were horrific; they were just another product, a disposable item to be sold or thrown away. I watched in horror as the seller prepared to discard them, deeming them worthless because of their infections. I could not stand it. The helplessness I felt was overwhelming, and without a single thought, I told him I would take all three. I paid him and walked out, my heart heavy with a mix of sorrow and a newfound, fierce sense of purpose. I exited that market with a promise to myself: I would never, ever buy a pet again. That day, I truly understood that the phrase "adopt,

don't shop" isn't just a slogan; it's a plea to save a life and a change the way the Industry works.

The next few days were a blur of vet visits, medicine, and endless care. It was a steep learning curve, understanding their needs and nursing them back to health. But as their eyes cleared and their little bodies grew stronger, so did my love for them. These three little boys—my first rescue "sons" Glen, Cookie and Bruno—had a profound impact on me. I am now the proud mother of four sons: three mischievous, fluffy felines and one beautiful human.

What began as a heartbreaking encounter in a crowded pet market turned into a lifelong mission of love. Glen, Cookie, Bruno, and Titli didn't just find a home — they built a family that healed together.

Yet, a part of me always longed for a daughter to complete our family. Then, I came across a post online about an adoption for a cat named Titli. Her story broke my heart. She was a beautiful Maine Coon, but had a squint and a severe skin infection. She was going to be euthanized because no one wanted her. But as I looked at her picture, I saw not her flaws, but her soul. The NGO was looking for a home with experience in Persian care, and with my three boys, now around three years old,

I knew I had the knowledge Titli needed. She was the daughter I had been searching for.

Bringing her home was a new kind of challenge. We went through our share of ups and downs, from all of them getting sick at once to the complicated process of introducing and socializing four cats. It's a journey that requires immense patience. My approach was to go slow and create a safe, neutral space for each cat. I started by keeping them separate, letting them get used to each other's scents by swapping blankets. Then, I introduced them through a baby gate, allowing them to see each other without direct contact. I used positive reinforcement, offering treats and praise whenever they were calm around each other. We got separate litter boxes, toys, and made sure each one had their own space. It took about six months of dedicated effort, but it was worth every single moment.

Today, my four cats are inseparable. They are a testament to the power of adoption and the beauty of giving a second chance. I started my journey in the ugly world of pet markets, but I ended up with a home full of love, laughter, and a family that rescued me just as much as I rescued them.

Avanti Pet Care Launches Dog Food Brand 'Avant Furst' in India







HOW TO TRAIN A RESCUE DOG?

Rescue Dogs can make excellent pets. It requires lots of patience and time in many cases.

Rescue dog behavior issues often stem from past trauma or lack of socialization. As a result, they can develop certain logical coping behaviors based on how their previous life worked. Compassionate adoptive parents try to understand the situation of rescue dog. And it will take some time for dogs to learn that they're not in that life anymore. But you may see ongoing.



- Flinching when people approach, especially holding objects
- Resource guarding (toys, food, or even spaces like a favorite spot on the couch)
- Excessive barking or whining due to anxiety
- Chewing and destructive behavior as a coping mechanism
- Growling
- Relieving themselves (pee & potty) in inappropriate places

Rescue dogs may also be malnourished and need to see a vet for conditions they developed as a result. Improving their nutrition is critically important for both dog health and bonding, as they learn that you care and give them the good stuff like high value treats or toys.

Let them settle in at their own pace. While most puppies are relaxed and inquisitive, adult dogs may be worried when they arrive at your home. You may find they hide at first and don't seem to want to interact with you. Don't worry – this is perfectly normal. To help them relax you should let them go at their own pace.

Allow them to spend time on their own without disruptions and come to you when they are ready. They may come over and look at you, sit nearby or drop a toy at your feet.

I strictly suggest to avoid any visitors to come home during this time and make sure it is calm and quiet, so they get familiar with their new surroundings in peace.

THERE ARE SOME KEY POINTS LISTED BELOW TO CONSIDER WHEN YOU START TRAINING A RESCUE DOG.

1. Be Ready for Unpredictability

Rescue dogs often carry "invisible" baggage—fear, anxiety, or just a lack of understanding about what life in a loving home should feel like. Training a rescue dog isn't just about teaching them commands. It's about building trust and creating a safe environment to thrive.



Rescue dogs often carry emotional scars, but with steady routines, positive reinforcement, and gentle guidance, they can thrive. This article walks you through simple, effective steps to help your rescue transition from fear to confidence.

2. Start Building Trust

Most rescues received some socialization at the shelter before adoption, so they've at least overcome one hurdle. But they may still be skittish.

Trust is built over time as the new family member learns that you act in predictable ways.

For Rescue dog, this meant creating a predictable routine. Dogs thrive on structure. Every day, you must follow the same schedule: meals at the same time, walks in the same places, and consistent rules (like no jumping on the couch, no matter how cute he looked).

3. Give Them a Safe Space

Crate training is one of the first rescue dog training commands I recommend. When presented to a dog correctly, a crate becomes

like a wolf's den is to a wolf. It's a warm, cozy place where they feel safe.

The same principles apply to a rescue dog. But in rescue dog's case, there was no way he was going in a crate—probably because of bad experiences. So, I will teach him a simple place command.

Flexibility in training a rescue dog is important

4. Use Positive Reinforcement for Rescue Dog Training

It's essential never to use punishment for rescue dog behavior issues. It destroys trust, and often, it's more of what the dog was used to in its previous home.



I keep treats in training pouch which I can carry on myself all the time. It makes rewarding him quickly and consistently easier.

Positive reinforcement became my secret weapon in training Bruno. Every time he did something "constructive"—whether it was sitting calmly when I put on his leash or not barking at the neighbor's cat—he got a reward. And when I say "reward," I don't just mean praise or a pat on the head.

I mean treats — small enough that I'm not running his dinner but irresistible enough that he starts making the connection between certain behaviors and rewards.

5. Choose High Value Dog Treats

The right treats make all the difference. High-value dog treats, were exactly what I needed to help Bruno turn a corner. These healthy, protein-packed treats got his attention fast and kept

him motivated during training sessions.

While lung bites are great for quick rewards, more substantial dog treats helped alleviate anxiety and boredom, so he became more receptive to training sessions.

6. Keep Dog Training Sessions Short

Five to ten minutes of focused training is better than an hour of frustration for both of you.

Always try to end these short sessions on a high note. For example, when Bruno was struggling to learn the down, we returned to basic with "sit". I rewarded him. And we ended the sessions with positive feelings he could carry into his next session.

7. Begin Basic Training

Training your dog to perform basic skills on command builds trust and cooperation.

Commands like sit, down and go to Crate, etc., help your dog feel safe and stay safe.

Please seek a professional trainer help always when you are not sure how to start the process. It's always helpful to hire a professional K9 trainer who can help your rescue dog and the family.

SEASONAL GROOMING CHALLENGES



Keeping Your Pet Comfortable All Year Round

As the seasons change, so do the grooming needs of our pets. Temperature fluctuations, humidity levels, and environmental factors can all affect your pet's coat, skin, and overall comfort. Whether you have a long-haired dog, a short-coated cat, or a double-coated breed, each season brings its own set of grooming challenges. Understanding these seasonal changes can help pet parents stay proactive and keep their pets looking and feeling their best all year long.

warmer weather. This is especially true for double-coated breeds such as Golden Retrievers, Huskies, and German Shepherds.

The Challenge: Excessive shedding can lead to matting, tangles, and fur accumulation around the house. Allergies may also spike due to increased pollen and dander.

The Solution: Regular brushing, at least three to four times a week, helps remove dead hair and distribute natural oils, promoting a healthier coat. Using a deshedding tool or grooming rake can significantly reduce loose fur. It's also a good time for a professional grooming session to remove undercoats and deep tangles. Bathing

Spring is a time of renewal, not just for nature, but for your pet's coat as well. As temperatures rise, many pets begin to shed their thick winter coats to prepare for



with a mild, moisturizing shampoo can help manage dander and keep skin hydrated.

2 SUMMER: HEAT, HUMIDITY, AND SKIN ISSUES

Summer brings heat, humidity, and the risk of skin infections, ticks, and fleas. Pets can become uncomfortable, especially those with thick coats or sensitive skin. Overheating and sunburn are also concerns for light-colored or short-haired pets.





The Journey of Pet Happiness



In conversation with Goutam Guha - Founder of PGPET and Yancal International, he delves into his journey from being a corporate employee to becoming one of the leading pet companies. He put different hats of a distributor, retailer and manufacturer.

Q: WHAT INSPIRED YOU TO START PGPET AND YANCAL INTERNATIONAL IN 2009 WHEN THE INDUSTRY WAS AT A VERY EARLY STAGE?

A: I can tell you that back in 2009, By qualification I am Cost Accountant and was working as a Tax Manager at Haldia Petrochemicals Limited (HPL) in Kolkata. At that time, I noticed that many pet parents were looking for quality services, whether in products, grooming, or veterinary care but such options were very limited. One of my friends had a pet, and I remember they were struggling to find a good veterinary clinic for their dog. That incident stayed with me. Meanwhile, as I continued my job in the petrochemical industry, I started thinking about how I could contribute to creating more job opportunities for people and also do something meaningful for society.

I realized that as long as I stayed in a job, my ability to create those opportunities would be limited. So, I decided to take the entrepreneurial route. That's when

I saw potential in the pet care sector, an industry full of passionate, emotional people who genuinely love their pets but lacked access to quality products and services. That thought became my turning point. I entered the pet care industry in 2009, and over the years, we've gradually built our business. Now, after about 15–16 years in the industry, my focus remains on two things — contributing to the growth of the pet care ecosystem and creating job opportunities for others. That's the small story behind how it all began.

Q: WHAT WERE THE INITIAL HURDLES AND CHALLENGES THAT YOU FACED WHEN YOU FIRST TRIED TO ESTABLISH YOUR BUSINESS?

A: In the early days, I used to finish my job as Tax Manager at HPL by 5:30 p.m., then head straight to the Burrabazar wholesale market to buy materials or receive materials from transport. I'd load everything into a car or taxi, take it to my small godown, and work on accounting till late at night-sometimes 1 a.m. It was tough, but I never saw it as a challenge.

It was my passion and dream that kept me going. When you truly love what you're building- time, place, and effort stop mattering.

Q: HOW IMPORTANT IT IS TO HAVE KNOWLEDGE IN FINANCE FOR A STARTUP AND HOW DID YOUR BACKGROUND HELP IN GROWING YOUR BUSINESS?

A: Coming from a finance background, I realized early on how crucial cost and management accounting is in running a business, especially for startups like ours that couldn't afford high-end consultants in the beginning. My training helped me understand every aspect of fixed cost, variable cost and other hidden costs and how each impacts decision-making. Many entrepreneurs tend to overlook these small but critical details, yet they often decide the fate of a project. Learning to approach business through data-driven systems, tracking every cost component, and applying financial discipline from the start became the foundation of my journey.

That financial mindset has shaped how I built and managed my pet care business from scratch. It taught me to remodel operations whenever cash flow or profitability became a concern and to make every move with calculated precision. Thanks to this grounding in finance, I've been able to create systems that are efficient, data-based, and sustainable, helping me take the right decisions at the right time while maintaining a healthy balance between growth and stability.

Q: WHAT ARE THE KIND OF TRENDS IN THE INDIAN PET INDUSTRY?

A: If I have to describe the transformation of the pet industry in one word, it would be humanization. Back in 2009, people certainly loved their pets, but they were still seen as companions, not family. The mindset was very different - pet care was basic, spending was limited, and the idea of "pet parenting" barely existed. But after COVID, everything changed. People began to see their pets as true family members, even as their own children. This emotional bond brought a new level of care, attention, and willingness to invest in their pets' happiness and health.



Today, this humanization has reshaped the entire industry. Pet parents now prefer premium food, organic treats, stylish accessories, and advanced healthcare products - spending thousands where earlier they spent only a few hundred. Every product category, from toys to tick collars, has evolved to meet this growing demand for quality and comfort. The shift is not just in products but in mindset, pets are no longer "animals at home," they are family. And this one change, this humanization, continues to drive the industry's growth and innovation.

Q: CAN YOU SHARE THE MOTIVATION BEHIND YOUR BOOK "THE SECRETS OF DOG ACCESSORIES" AND ITS TAKEAWAYS?

A: With five stores under our brand, I've had the opportunity to interact directly with countless pet parents and observe their buying behavior. Over time, I realized that most pet parents tend to purchase based on their own preferences rather than their pets' actual needs. In our industry, the buyer and the end user are different, unlike other sectors where both are the same. For example, a pet parent may choose a collar or harness because it looks attractive, but it might not be comfortable or safe for the pet. This insight helped me understand how important it is to guide pet parents to make choices based on comfort, safety, and wellness rather than aesthetics.

What many don't realize is that accessories need to be chosen as carefully as food or medicine. The right bowl, leash, or harness varies depending on the breed, size, and behavior of the pet. A bowl suitable for a Cocker Spaniel may not work for a Pug, just as the accessories for a large breed should differ from those for a small one. This understanding of product functionality and pet comfort is essential for responsible pet parenting. Educating pet parents about these nuances can go a long way in ensuring the safety, health, and overall well-being of pets.

Q: WHAT ARE THE KEY THINGS THAT ONE SHOULD KEEP IT IN MIND IN ORDER TO KEEP A SUCCESSFUL FRANCHISE BUSINESS?

A: When it comes to offering franchises, I believe in quality over quantity. For me, selecting the right

partner is far more important than expanding quickly. I don't hand over a franchise just to increase numbers, I prefer to work with one ideal person in a year if needed. The key is to choose people who are genuinely passionate about pets, mentally prepared to carry the brand forward, and financially capable of managing it responsibly. To ensure this, we follow a structured selection process that includes detailed questionnaires and evaluations. This helps us assess the applicant's intent and mindset beyond what they say in conversation. Once chosen, we make sure the franchise model is simple, profitable, and completely transparent — no hidden costs or unrealistic promises. After all, a franchise is a partnership, and trust is the foundation of any long-term collaboration.

Equally important is providing thorough training and operational support. Every franchise partner receives a comprehensive 12-month guide that covers product knowledge, store layout, seasonal merchandising, display techniques, and customer engagement strategies. We also ensure efficient supply chain and inventory management, maintaining fair pricing that allows our partners to stay competitive in the market. Charging franchisees more than market rates or treating them differently from company-owned stores is something I strongly avoid. I believe that franchisees should feel like an extension of our own team — partners in growth rather than just business associates. This approach may grow slower, but it builds a stronger, more sustainable network based on integrity, transparency, and shared success.

Q: MY FINAL QUESTION IS, HOW DO YOU SEE THE GROWTH TRAJECTORY FOR PGPET AND YANCAL INTERNATIONAL? DO YOU HAVE PLANS OR AMBITIONS TO

EXPAND YOUR PRODUCT LINE, SCALE MANUFACTURING, OR EXPORT TO INTERNATIONAL MARKETS?

A: Our business operates across both B2C and B2B segments. We currently have two manufacturing units one in Kolkata and another in Ghaziabad, where we produce a range of pet apparels such as T shirts, Jackets, Sherwani, Beds and many more as well as Pet accessories like Leash, Collar, harness and many more products. Additionally, under our in-house brand Petex, we manufacture a range of pet cosmetics including perfumes, shampoos, Conditioner, Serum and many more which are already being exported to several countries. Moving forward, we plan to expand exports, strengthen our white-label manufacturing for wholesalers, and introduce new initiatives such as pet insurance, teleconsultation, and eventually mobile grooming services through our e-commerce platform, www.petindiaonline.com. We are also working on innovative bedding solutions that provide cooling in summers and warmth in winters, all designed to enhance pet comfort and wellness.

Every business decision we take is driven by data rather than intuition. From identifying trending products to planning production and pricing strategies, data guides every step. My background in cost and management accounting has taught me the value of relying on facts over feelings because when you bootstrap a business, every rupee and every decision counts. This data-driven approach helps us stay agile, profitable, and ahead of trends, while ensuring that our customers always receive quality products at the right price. Ultimately, success lies in balancing innovation with financial discipline and in staying grounded in both passion and precision.


On 10th October, 2025, we closed the entries and on 11th October, 2025, we announced our winner!

RABIES

WHAT EVERY PET PARENT SHOULD KNOW

Rabies is a viral disease that attacks the brain and nervous system. It is almost always fatal once symptoms appear, but the good news is that it is 100% preventable. As pet parents, a little preparation goes a long way in protecting your family, your pets, and your community.

How Rabies Spreads (And How It Does Not)

Rabies is carried by mammals and spreads mainly when saliva from an infected animal enters the body. Most often through bites, sometimes scratches or saliva on open wounds or mucous membranes (eyes, mouth). In India, dog bites are the leading cause of human rabies. You cannot get rabies from casual contact like touching fur or from intact skin.

The Simple, Lifesaving First Step After Any Bite

If anyone in your family or your pet is bitten or scratched by an animal:

- Wash the wound immediately with running water and soap for at least 15 minutes.
- Do not apply chili, haldi, soil, or herbal pastes to the wound.

- Seek medical/veterinary care right away. Do not wait to "see how it looks tomorrow".

That first wash dramatically lowers the amount of virus at the wound site. Medical teams will then guide you on protective treatment.

Protection After a Bite: PEP (Post-Exposure Protection)


After a potential exposure, doctors focus on two things:

- Thorough wound care (that 15-minute wash you started), and
- A course of anti-rabies vaccines, with rabies immunoglobulin (RIG) for certain high-risk wounds. The vaccine is given intramuscularly on days 0, 3, 7, 14, and 28.

PEP stops the virus before it reaches the brain. It is highly effective when started promptly and completed as advised by your doctor.

Quick reassurance: If a scheduled vaccine dose is missed, do not panic, go back as soon as you can and follow your doctor's advice. Completing the course matters.

National Guidelines for Rabies Prophylaxis, 2019



National Rabies Control Programme

Protection Before a Bite: PrEP (Pre-Exposure Protection)

Some people benefit from vaccination before any exposure- think vets, animal handlers, children who frequently interact with animals, or families in areas with many free-roaming dogs, which in practice includes most of us in India. PrEP "trains" the immune system in advance so the body responds faster and better if a bite ever occurs. Your doctor can advise whether PrEP makes sense for your household.

Your Pet's Best Shield: Regular Vaccination

Keeping your dog or cat vaccinated on schedule is the single most important step a pet parent can take. It protects your pet and acts as a community shield, reducing the spread of rabies. In India, most pets receive annual rabies boosters. Your veterinarian will guide you based on age, health status, and local guidelines.

What About the Biting Animal?

If the biter is a healthy dog or cat that can be observed, authorities/owners may keep it under 10-day observation.

If it stays healthy, the risk is lower. With stray or unknown animals, assume risk and start PEP immediately. Do not wait to locate the animal.

A Shared Responsibility:

India aims to dramatically reduce rabies deaths in the coming years through better vaccination, awareness, and timely care. Pet parents are a vital part of that effort: vaccinate your pets, teach children safe animal behaviour, and know what to do after a bite.

Bottom line: Wash the wound, seek care promptly, complete the advised vaccination course—and keep your pet's rabies shots up to date.

With simple, timely steps, rabies is preventable. Together, we can consign this ancient disease to history.

Common Myths Busted

MYTH	FACT
Rabies only spreads through dog bites.	Any mammal can transmit rabies , including cats and bats.
Indoor pets do not need vaccines.	Even indoor pets can be exposed (doors left open, visiting animals, travel). Vaccination is still essential.
Rabies is treatable once it starts.	Unfortunately, no. Prevention is the only cure.
A small puppy's bite is harmless.	Size of the animal or wound does not predict risk. Treat all bites seriously.
Since I had my full set of anti-rabies injections a few months ago, I don't need them again if I get bitten now.	With every fresh bite or scratch, you must take 2 booster doses (Day 0 and Day 3) — no matter when you last completed your anti-rabies shots.
